# PROGRAMS IN A BOX









## SEEK BY INATURALIST

- Gamified version of iNaturalist designed for younger people
- Includes challenges and scavenger hunts to find specific things
- Simpler user interface focused entirely on making observations of the natural world
- Best used in a program led by a naturalist to supplement the education and interpretation, but also able to stand on its own
- Can be cross-posted to iNaturalist to be used in citizen science data-sets and for Al training



## GEOCACHING

- Strong culture of puzzles and cryptography
- Likely dozens of geocaches nearby your facility, or anywhere visited by off-site programs
- Can be done through the app or entirely phone-free
  - App is very limited without subscription
  - Website plus a handheld GPS is more robust without subscription
- Badges for Scouting American and Girl Scouts of the USA
- Lots of free lesson plans available online





## NATURALIST TOOLS





## FLORA & FAUNA 1 (PRESENTER'S FAUS)

#### iNaturalist

- Uses phone camera and AI to help identify flora and fauna
- Also shares observations for user review to help solidify IDs and train AI
- Powerful citizen science tool
  - Create or join specific data-gathering projects
  - Huge amount of observations available to researchers
- Free

#### Merlin Bird ID (and eBird)

- Identify birds by song, photo, or through a guidebook style workflow
- Extensive information on local birds anywhere in US
- Can be paired with eBird to track your own checklist and contribute to scientific tracking and research
- Free



## FLORA & FAUNA 2 (OTHER POPULAR APPS)

#### Picture This

- Uses phone camera for powerful AI driven plant identification,
- Includes a large amount of domestic plants, including garden and houseplants
- Includes tools for caring for garden and house plants
  - Light meter
  - Photo based glossary of plant health issues for some species
- Full version requires subscription

## Pl@ntNet

- Al Driven plant ID, with a strong history of citizen science
- Allows for creation of groups to pool several individuals contributions in an area together into one map and dataset
- Shares observations for user validation
- Free



## NIGHT SKY

## SkyView

- Augmented reality app for identifying stars, constellations, and other celestial bodies
- Simple, intuitive user interface
- Works offline
- One time purchase

### Stellarium

- App for learning about the night sky
- Huge catalog of stars and deep sky objects with detailed information on each
- No augmented reality function
- Free, subscription, and one time purchase options





## OTHER TOPICS

#### Rockd


- App from University of Wisconsin-Madison with information on geology throughout most of the US
- Citizen Science Users can report rock outcroppings with photos and identifications to help build a better map of geologic layers throughout US
- Free

- Five separate apps for insects, birds, fungi, fish, and rocks
- Books, articles, and more available in app
- Super polished user interface
- Free or subscription options



# MAPS & NAUIGATION





## THE BIG ONES

#### **All Trails**

- Moderate detail proprietary topo maps,
   3D terrain maps, and more
- Simple user interface
- Good offline functionality
- Live tracking feature
- Simple & effective tools for making downloadable and printable routes & maps (website)
- Less Expensive

#### **Gaia GPS**

- Highly detailed proprietary topo maps, USGS maps, and more
- More complicated but more robust user interface
- Excellent offline functionality
- Powerful tools for making downloadable routes & maps, printed maps have less detail (website)
- More Expensive



## NICHE USES

### Topo Maps +

- Extremely detailed topo maps, including USGS, Natural Atlas, Thunderforest, USFS, and more
- Smaller library of hiking routes & trails
- Best for individuals with already solid navigation skills
- Variety of subscription tiers with different features

#### Far Out

- Regularly updated guidebook style narrative guides and maps
- Limited locations available, always adding more
- No free option, but one time purchase for each guide



## WORTH MENTIONING

#### **Hiking Project**

- Crowdsourced routes and trail conditions, including guidebook style narrative instructions
- Small but typically experienced and passionate userbase
- Fewer trails and locations
- Free

#### **Goat Maps**

- Mapping and navigation tool currently in beta testing
- Extremely detailed, robust, and customizable maps and navigation both on and offline
- Will require a subscription for most features

#### Apple Maps

- Apple Maps has begun to add trail maps and hiking navigation.
- Currently has very detailed trail maps in National Parks, but very limited mapping anywhere else
- Too soon to tell if it will become robust enough to challenge The Big Ones for usefulness
- Free, but only available on Apple devices

## LIGHTNING

## My Lightning Tracker Pro

- Lightning tracking map with customizable alerts
- Requires data or wifi connection
- Reliably and quickly alerts user of nearby lightning strikes in real time
- Simple user interface
- One time purchase

## lightningmaps.org (web based)

- Lightning monitoring website including thunder mapping
- Uses several data sources; extremely accurate in North America and Europe
- Detailed archives of past strikes



## TRIP & TRAVEL

#### Drive Weather

- Weather forecasts along a travel route
- Automatically takes drive-times into forecast
- Includes road condition forecasts
- Subscription for most features

## mountain-forecast.com (app or web based)

- Weather forecast specific to mountains and ranges
- Includes weather at several elevations
- Extremely detailed forecasts
- All features available for free on website
- Limited features on free app, full features are subscription based

- Any List Sharable shopping lists, recipes, packing lists, or any other checklist for multiple users
- Grog Knots Excellent animated knots, iOS only
- Knots 3D Also good, available on Android & iOS
- Peak Finder Augmented reality app for identifying surrounding features
- rigrite Simple to use calculator for forces on anchors for ropes courses, slacklines, and climbing
- Pokemon Go I'm a nerd like that, okay
- Fitness Trackers I just use whatever comes on my phone
